Winemaker Notes

Trentadue Winery has more than a four decade long tradition of making Petite Sirah and through the years has become one of the top producers of this California grape. This 2008 bottling is a return to an Estate Petite Sirah in the Trentadue line. This vintage was a nice follow up to the stellar vintage of 2007. The wine's characteristics are typical to our Estate fruit with aromas and flavors of dark stone fruit, blueberry, plums and blackberry. The color is intense dark purple with a full body and a long, juicy and viscous finish. Further aeration reveals deeper, complex aromas of leather, cocoa powder, molasses and maple. This is a wine that will get better with age but is enjoyable now.
