La Storia, or the history of fine winemaking for the Trentadue family, goes back several generations. In keeping with tradition, these limited release La Storia wines have been expertly crafted from carefully selected fruit grown on our Alexander Valley Estate. Showcasing the best fruit our Estate can yield and the best wines our talented winemaker and his team can produce, this tier of reserve wines are a shining example of the dedication to quality that the Trentadue Family has stood for, for over 40 years.



Cuvee 32

Made in the tradition of the great wines of Tuscany, this wine exhibits a lovely dark ruby color. The nose carries notes of chocolate, ripe black cherries and baking spices such as cloves and cinnamon. On the palate, flavors of chocolate are reinforced with blackberry, cedar and tobacco. The tannin structure is firm and well-defined, supporting a full body and lively, yet balanced acidity, suggesting a wide range of food pairings. The Cuvee 32 is a favorite of visitors to our tasting room and among the members of our La Storia Wine Club.



Zinfandel

Crafted from Estate Geyserville Ranch fruit, the La Storia Zinfandel is a superlative example of our commitment to making premium wines. Dark red-black in color, delivering a nose brimming over with aromas of ripe plums, briary raspberry and blackberry preserves, this Zinfandel explodes on the palate with jammy flavors of berry, plum and vivid black cherry. This is a big, juicy, powerful and concentrated wine that shows the hedonistic side of this varietal and the reason for its huge following of zinophiles. With a full, but not overly heavy body, this complex Zin should evolve well over time.



Cabernet Sauvignon

The Cabernet grapes that we select for this wine come from Block 901, which is by far, the best block of Cab that we have on our Estate. Often rounding out the blend on this Cabernet Sauvignon are the other Bordeaux varietals of Petite Verdot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. This wine is a classic Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, with a nose of ripe sweet cherry and plums, developed aromas of leather, licorice and hints of cocoa powder and molasses. With proper cellaring, this wine should age well for another 10 plus years.



Petite Sirah

Trentadue Winery's historical roots are firmly grounded in this classic varietal. Leo Trentadue has been growing and producing Petite Sirah on his Estate since 1969 and this commitment and love for this grape has been culminated in the release of La Storia Petite Sirah. Produced from grapes grown only on the Trentadue Alexander Valley Estate, this wine will impress with a black, inky color and a firm, rich and chewy mouth feel. The aromas often indicate cherry, blackberry and chocolate as well as an intriguing hint of cigar box. La Storia Petite Sirah exhibits a very big and firm structure that will allow for this wine to age gracefully for years to come. A true Sonoma County standout.
